4.1 Permitted uses of Site content

The collective subscription to RetroNews taken out by the Subscriber enables the beneficiaries of the subscription to use the basic features of the site, i.e. searching and viewing press content, in accordance with the General Conditions of Use of the RetroNews site (hereinafter the "GCU").

The collective subscription taken out by the Subscriber also allows its beneficiaries to use advanced search and viewing services as well as additional features (such as full-text search, annotation, quotation, downloading, export, copy/paste, etc.), in accordance with the uses of the site provided for in the General Conditions of Sale of the RetroNews Premium Service (hereinafter the "Premium General Terms and Conditions").

Within the framework of the present subscription, the use of the RetroNews site is authorised only for strictly personal and non-commercial purposes.

By way of exception to the above, beneficiaries of the collective subscription to RetroNews may also make the following solely collective uses of the content:

- the beneficiaries in the teaching profession are authorised, within the framework of this subscription, to use the site and distribute its contents free of charge to their users, within the strict framework of the courses, examinations and educational workshops which they give in classes.

- beneficiaries who are students or researchers are authorised, in the context of their scientific studies or research and for non-commercial purposes, to reuse and disseminate the archives of the site they are researching in their publications such as dissertations, doctoral theses or scientific publications published under their name, provided that the name of the author and the press body of the publication and the source are consistently cited as follows:

“These documents are excerpted from the RetroNews Site and are accessible at the address www.RetroNews.fr / Any re-use of this/these document(s) must be in accordance with the subscription conditions provided for by the RetroNews site.”

- beneficiaries are authorised, via the export function of a page or excerpt of a press Article published on RetroNews, to incorporate the archives offered with this function on their websites and blogs, provided that they act strictly within the framework of their personal activity, for strictly non-commercial purposes and that they do not modify or adapt the exported archives. Any use of the site's export function outside this framework is subject to the express prior authorisation of BnFP.

It is specified that the export option on RetroNews site archives by the beneficiaries is expressly prohibited when intended for use on pornographic sites and blogs, sites instigating violence, containing racist or xenophobic messages, promoting a political or religious thesis or dedicated to a brand, a public or private company, a product or a service.

In addition, beneficiaries may not engage in advertising, promotion or sponsorship on the page imported to their site or blog, or make it available for a fee.

Article 4.2 Prohibited uses of site content

Any use of the contents of the site by the Subscriber or the beneficiaries of the collective subscription, not listed in Article 4.1 above, is strictly prohibited.

In particular, the use by the Subscriber or subscription beneficiaries of content from the site for commercial purposes is expressly prohibited.
